## **2023 GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND REGULATIONS.**

1. All drivers must be FULL financial members of a Club affiliated with the Australian Carriage Driving Society. Membership may be checked at the nomination office.
  2. All events will be conducted in accordance with the ACDS Show Driving Manual. It is the responsibility of the driver to have knowledge and understanding of these rules and guidelines.
  3. Dress requirements will be presentation or costume dress, as appropriate in all events, including prize presentations.
  4. Neither the hosting Club nor any member of an ACDS Club will accept liability for any loss or damage to horses, vehicles, competitors, spectators or property. All entrants and their assistants attend and compete at their own risk.
  5. The organisers reserve the right to change the program according to the conditions of the day.
  6. Classes may be added or combined, with appropriate Champion and Reserve Champion awarded, at the discretion of the organizing Committee. The minimum requirement for division of classes shall be 3 entries in each class after the split.
  7. THE JUDGE'S DECISION WILL BE FINAL. No ribbon will be awarded if the exhibits in any section are considered by the judge to be of insufficient merit.
  8. All disputes must be accompanied by \$50, in writing and presented to the officiating Chief Ring Steward for consideration by the Disputes Committee within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the event. Should the appeal be upheld, the deposit will be refunded.
  9. It is the driver's responsibility to report to classes on time. CLASSES WILL NOT BE HELD UP WAITING FOR LATE DRIVERS.
  10. All equines must be at least 3 years of age to compete.
  11. A NOVICE is one not to have won more than 4 FIRST places in any open class at any ACDS Show or any other association, ie height, weight, sulky, buggy. Exempt classes: Restrictive classes such as breed-driven, novelty, turnout, whip, pleasure and CDE.
  12. A veterinarian will be on call, if required, at the competitor's expense.
  13. The decision of the ACDSQB, hosting Club, Executive, or any sub-committee they may appoint, on all points relating to this Championship shall be final, without recourse to law.
