GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. This event will be judged under the Rules for ACDS Combined Driving Events 3rd Edition effective 15 October 2020 and additional regulations in this schedule. Particular attention is drawn to compliance with the Code of Conduct for Welfare of the Horse refer to Article 933.
- 2. Competitors are aware of, and agree to pay, the applicable excess which applies to any insurance claim against the ACDS Insurance Policy which may arise out of their participation in the event.
- 3. Appeals together with \$50.00 are to be lodge within 30 minutes of the scores being posted for each phase. Money will be refunded unless, in the opinion of the Appeals Committee, the appeal is found to be frivolous.
- 4. Entry fee **must** accompany entry form or copy of Direct Deposit receipt.
- 5. At both presentations competitors must be dressed in neat attire. Horses must have their number on their bridle at vet checks. Friday afternoon vet check LEVEL1 ONLY.
- 6. It is the responsibility of competitors to present themselves for inspection, at least **15 minutes** prior to their marathon start time.
- 7. Dogs must be <u>restrained and on a leash at all times</u>. The Organising Committee will enforce this.
- 8. No refund of entry fee after closing date without veterinary certificate/doctor certificate.
- 9. Right of admission to the Kootingal Pony Club Grounds, Moonbi is reserved.
- 10. STABLES WILL BE ALLOCATED & ALL STABLES MUST BE LEFT CLEANED, THERE WILL BE A FEW RAKES AND BARROWS AVAILABLE. You cannot store gear in a stable unless you pay the extra stabling fee with your booking.
- 11. CAMPING SITES WITH POWER ARE LIMITED AND WILL BE ALLOCATED ON A FIRST BOOKED BASIS.
- 12. Prize winners who **leave early**, please organise a friend to collect on your behalf.
- 13. THE ORGANISING COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO COMBINE CLASSES AFTER CLOSE OF ENTRIES.

DRESSAGE ARENAS x2

Dressage will commence @ 8.30am on Saturday 9th November in the main arena of the grounds. Dressage arenas will be 100m x 40m. There will be a steward at A.

OBSTACLE CONES DRIVING

The obstacle cones driving shall be conducted as a timed/fault competition and will commence @ 2pm on Saturday 9th November in the arena behind the hall. Your wheel width will be measured after you have driven the cones course.

MARATHON

The marathon will consist of 3 sections, with a total distance of approximately 14klm including 5 marathon obstacles. Section A will be held on public roads so be aware of the road rules and give way to traffic, these are mainly roads with grassed verges.
